**RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (TRADESMAN) (MALE & FEMALE)
IN BORDER SECURITY FORCE FOR THE YEAR 2019**

Applications are invited from **MALE & FEMALE** Indian Citizens for filling up **1763* vacancies (1761 Vacancies for MALE candidates and 02 vacancies for FEMALE candidates)** for the post of **Constable (Tradesman)** Exam 2019 in Border Security Force in the pay Matrix Level-3, Pay scale Rs.21,700-69,100/- of 7th CPC (Revised Pay Structure) and other allowances as admissible to Central Govt. employees from time to time. In addition, Ration allowance, Medical Assistance, free accommodation, free leave pass, etc. are granted which are admissible to BSF employees.

***State Wise, Trade Wise and Category Wise distribution of vacancies are attached at Appendix-'A' & 'B'**

(2). **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR APPLYING FOR ABOVE POST:-**

1.	BSF will conduct recruitment for the post of Constable (Tradesman) (Male & Female candidates) in BSF for the year 2019.
2.	Candidates are advised to go through the requirement of educational qualification, age, physical standards, physical efficiency test, medical standard etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post, before applying.
3.	BSF reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage of the selection process, if he is not qualifying any of the prescribed eligibility criteria.
4.	The application Form and Admit Cards (placed at Annexure-I to IV) must be filled by the candidates in his own handwriting in capital/block letters. Correction, if any, should be legible and attested by the candidates.
5.	Candidate will apply for only one post/trade.
6.	Candidates seeking reservation benefits for SC/ST/OBC category must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility conditions prescribed in the Advertisement Notice. They should also be in possession of certificates in the prescribed format available at Annexure – VI & VII in support of their claim at the time of application failing which their application will be rejected at initial stage.
7.	The envelope containing the application form must be superscripted in bold letters as “APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (TRADESMAN) MALE & FEMALE IN BSF EXAMINATION 2019”
8.	Applications, which are not on prescribed format or not accompanied by the required documents or incomplete or defective shall be summarily rejected at initial stage i.e at the time of Preliminary Scrutiny of applications. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained under any circumstances.
9.	Candidates belonging to the Physically Handicapped category are not eligible to apply for this recruitment.
10.	An employee serving in the same rank and pay grade will not be entitled to apply for said post.

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11.	Persons serving in Govt/Semi Govt department may send their applications through proper channel alongwith "No objection Certificate" as per format available at Annexure-V .
12.	Closing Date: Application Form duly filled up in the given format should be sent to concerned RAs/Headquarters, under which their state falls, on or before 03 Mar' 2019 2019 through post alongwith requisite documents (for normal area). Closing date of applications for far flung areas i.e North Eastern States, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul & Spiti Districts and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh State, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Union Territory of Lakshadweep is 18 Mar' 2019 . Application form received after closing date will not be entertained.
13.	BSF will not be responsible for any postal delay.
14.	The recruitment board shall not be liable for any claim arising out of any injury etc. suffered during the tests. The decision of the recruitment board shall be final in all matters connected with this recruitment.
15.	Mobile phone and other Electronic Gadgets are banned within the premises of the Examination Centers.
16.	The biometric methods will be used at all stages of the recruitment (in the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression, digital photograph and any specific identifying marks in the body may be used).
17.	Written examination will be conducted on OMR based answer sheets. OMR answer sheets will be rejected if mandatory fields/ovals like Name, Roll Number, Sex, Category, Question Booklet series code, Name of Trade etc. are unfilled or wrongly filled.
18.	Selected candidate will be Governed by BSF Act and Rules.
19.	On appointment they shall be covered under " New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme " applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government services w.e.f 01 st Jan, 2004.
20.	Finally selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in the Country as per the transfer policy of the Force.

NOTE: Final scrutiny of eligibility criteria with regards to age, educational qualification, caste, physical standard will be undertaken at the time of final selection/medical examination. Therefore, candidature will be accepted provisionally till the final selection. At the time of final selection when scrutiny is undertaken and if any claim made in application is not found substantiated then the candidature will be cancelled and the decision of BSF authority in this regard shall be final.

(3). (a)	Education Qualification	Matriculation or equivalent from a recognized University or Board with:- (i) Two years work experience in respective trades; (OR) (ii) One year certificate course from Industrial Training Institute/ Vocational Institute with at least one year experience in the trade; (OR) (iii) Two years Diploma from Industrial Training Institute in the trade or similar trade.
(b)	AGE	Between 18 to 23 years as on 1st August, 2019. Relaxation in respect of the candidates for SC/ST/OBC category and other special categories of personnel in accordance with the instructions issued by Central Govt. from time to time.

NOTE-I: Relaxation in height and chest (as the case may be) as mentioned above will be permissible on production of certificate in the proforma as prescribed in Annexure – VIII) from the competent authorities.

NOTE-II: The candidates who are declared 'Not Qualified' in PST i.e height and chest in the case of male & only height in the case of female may prefer an appeal on same day, if they so desire, to the Appellate Authority (either senior or superior than the Presiding Officer (PO) of the board). The decision of the Appellate Authority will be final and no further appeal or representation in this regard will be entertained thereafter. **There will be no appeal for PET**

(d) **MEDICAL STANDARD:-**

- (i) **Visual Standard:-** The visual standard of candidates will be examined as per revised uniform medical guidelines issued by MHA vide UO No. A.VI-1/2014-Rectt(SSB) dated 20.05.2015 as amended from time to time.

- (ii) The candidates must not have knock knees, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes. They must be in good mental and physical health for duties in all places including in high altitude and fit to serve border areas with extreme climatic conditions and must be free from any defect likely to interfere with efficient performance of the duties.

(5) **METHOD OF SELECTION:-**

The selection method will be as under:-

(A) **FIRST PHASE OF EXAMINATION**

Candidates whose offline application forms are found to be in order will be called to appear in PST/PET.

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(a) Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET):-

- (i) At the very beginning of the recruitment process, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will get eliminated.
- (ii) Those candidates who qualify in height bar test will be put through the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) which will be as under:-

- (iii) Those candidates who qualify in PET will be subject to bio-matric identification & screening of testimonials/documents and thereon chest (applicable to male candidates only) and weight measurement by the Board. The candidates who do not fulfill the laid down physical standards will be eliminated from recruitment process. **However, elimination on grounds of weight will be done at the time of medical examination only.**
- (iv) Pregnancy at the time of PET will be considered as disqualification and pregnant female candidates shall be rejected at this stage.
- (v) Original documents/testimonials of candidates will be checked by the Board of Officers and only eligible candidates will go to the next stage.

Note -I : No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-Servicemen.

Note-II : PET will be only qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.

(b) TRADE TEST :-

The candidates who qualify in the PST, PET & Documentation will be put through the respective Trade Test. **Each candidate will be allowed to appear for one trade test only. The Trade test will be qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.** The requisite skill/qualification for each trade are as under :-

- i) **Cobbler** : Polishing of shoes, handling tools, cutting of leather, repair & stitching of shoes.
- ii) **Tailor** : Taking measurement of persons, cutting of cloth and Stitching of uniform.
- iii) **Carpenter** : Handling tools, cutting of wood, fitting, polishing and Finishing of materials.
- iv) **Cook** : Cooking of Chappatti & Rice, Cooking of vegetable/Dal/Sambhar/Idli etc. for 100 men, cooking of meat/fish/egg/kheer.
- v) **Water Carrier** : Washing of utensils, kneading of Atta for making chappattis for about 100 men and cutting of vegetable etc.
- vi) **Washer man** : Washing of clothes, Ironing of Khaki, Cotton uniform, woolen and TC uniform.

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- vii) **Barber** : Handling of tools, haircutting and shaving.
- viii) **Sweeper** : Sweeping, cleaning of toilets and bathroom etc.
- ix) **Waiter** : Hygiene/sanitation, servicing of foods and allied matters.

(B) SECOND PHASE OF EXAMINATION

WRITTEN TEST for 100 marks :-

- (i) Successful candidate in the first phase examination i.e. PST, PET, Documentation and Trade Test will be called to appear in second phase of examination i.e. Written test which will be communicated to the candidates through admit card.
- (ii) The Written Test for 100 marks containing 100 questions (qualifying marks 35% for Gen Category & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for SC/ST/OBC) will consist of only OMR based objective type multiple choice questions to be answered using a **Blue or Black ball point pen only**.
- (iii) While all the question papers in an examination may contain the same set of questions, the question papers may be in different series, which will have the questions in different order.
- (iv) The question paper will consist of one objective type paper containing 100 questions carrying 100 marks with the following composition:-

- (v) All questions will be of objective multiple choice type. The papers can be answered either in Hindi or in English. The standard of the question should commensurate with the knowledge expected from a class-10th pass candidate.
- (vi) OMR Answer Sheet should be filled up by candidates correctly with Blue or Black ball point Pen only as per instructions given in OMR Answer Sheet.
- (vi) **All candidates are required to fill and shade, name, roll number, date of birth, language, Post/Trade, category and question booklet series code given in the OMR sheet because these informations are essential for evaluation of the answer sheet. Ovals as printed against each should be shaded properly, otherwise OMR sheets of candidates may not be evaluated by scanner machine and he/she will be declared fail for which candidate will himself/herself be responsible for such mistakes. No change/cutting/overwriting is permitted. Correction fluid should not be used. Hence the ovals should be filled carefully.**

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(C) THIRD PHASE EXAMINATION**(a) Detailed Medical Examination:-**

- (i) The candidates who qualify all the above stages i.e. PST, PET, Documentation, Trade Test and Written test will put through Detailed Medical Examination (DME) which will be carried out by Medical Board of Officers to assess their physical & medical fitness.
- (ii) The medical examination of candidates will be carried out as per revised uniform medical guidelines issued by MHA vide UO No. A.VI-1/2014-Rectt(SSB) dated 20.05.2015 as amended from time to time. The candidates must not have knock knees, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes.
- (iii) Candidates have to qualify all the stages of the third phase examination one by one. Any candidate not qualified any of the stage of examination, he/she will be eliminated from the recruitment process.
- (iv) Candidates having Tattoos will be considered as per following instructions:-
 - (a) **Content:** Being a secular country, the religious sentiments of our countrymen are to be respected and thus, tattoos depicting religious symbol or figures and the name as followed in Indian Army are to be permitted.
 - (b) **Location:** Tattoos marked on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm, being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands are to be allowed.
 - (c) **Size:** Size must be less than $\frac{1}{4}$ of the particular part (Elbow or Hand) of the body.
 - (d) **In case a candidate has undergone removal of tattoo(s) prior to appearing for recruitment process and the same has faded substantially, this will be treated as a "scar" and not a tattoo. Such candidates will be permitted to undergo the entire selection process with the approval of Presiding Officer of the recruitment Board. Further, the scar resulting due to removal of tattoo will be reviewed by the Medical Board of Officer during Detailed Medical Examination".**
- (v) Candidates will be called for medical examination in order of merit. Such candidates will be called till such time all vacancies in their respective categories are filled up.
- (vi) **For female candidates only:** In case of medical examination, "**Temporary Unfitness**" will not be allowed, however, any such female candidates who during the medical examination is found to be pregnant of twelve weeks or above, she shall be declared temporarily unfit and her appointment will be held in abeyance until the confinement is over.

(b) Review Medical Examination :-

- (i) The candidates who are declared Unfit in Detailed Medical Examination (DME) and not satisfied with the findings of the Initial Medical Examination, can submit their appeal within 15 days from the date of medical examination for appearing in **Review Medical Examination**.
- (ii) The appeal must be accompanied with a proof of his/her fitness certificate in the prescribed form with enclosing Demand Draft of **Rs. 25/-**, as a piece of evidence about the possibility of an **error of judgment** in the decision of DME board, who had examined him/her in the first instance.

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- (iii) The medical fitness certificate thus produced by the candidates will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the Medical Officer from Government District Hospital or above along with registration number given by Medical Council of India (MCI)/State Medical Council, to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected and declared unfit for service by BSF Medical Board.
- (iv) If the appeal of candidate is accepted by BSF Appellate Authority, his/her Review Medical Examination (RME) will be conducted thereafter. The candidate will be called on the date and time to be decided by BSF authority to appear before RME board.
- (v) The decision of RME board will be final. **No appeal will be entertained against the findings of Review Medical Examination.**
- (vi) **Any surgery conducted between the period of DME & RME for corrective measures of unfitness will not be accepted and be considered as 'unfit'**

(6). **FINAL MERIT LIST:-**

- (i) Final Merit list in each category namely, UR, SC, ST, OBC and Ex-Servicemen will be drawn separately in respect of each State/UT on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in the Written Examination.
- (ii) SC/ST/OBC candidates who are qualified on their own merit, without relaxed standards along with candidates belonging to UR candidates, will not be adjusted against the reserved vacancies. Such candidates will be accommodated against the Un-Reserved (UR) vacancies as per their position in the overall merit list. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst eligible SC, ST and OBC candidates.

(7) **RESOLUTION OF TIE CASES :-**

In case of tie in marks, the candidates with older age will be placed higher in the merit list. If the candidates of similar date of birth have obtained equal number of marks, the candidates whose name comes first in the alphabetic order (English) will be kept higher in the merit list.

(8). **ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-EMPLOYMENT OF EX-SERVICEMEN:-**

Only written test, trade test and medical examination will be conducted for Ex-servicemen. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent of military service plus 3 years is applicable. However, break in Army service and re-employment should not exceed 2 years. No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-servicemen.

(9) **WARDS OF SERVING BSF PERSONNEL:-**

Wards of BSF serving personnel may apply either from their Home State or from the State where his or her father/mother is posted/deployed at the time of recruitment. However, they will be considered against vacancies of domiciled Home State only. To avail this concession, they have to submit certificate in the format prescribed in **Annexure - X**. However, they will not be entitled to avail any relaxation of the State from which they are appearing if they are not actually domiciled in that State. Eligibility/relaxation of such candidates will be considered as applicable to them as per their domiciled State.

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(10). **DOMICILE CERTIFICATE:-**
