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NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from qualified Indian Citizens belonging to the non creamy layer of Other Backward Classes (Excluding Ezhavas, Thiyyas and Billavas, Muslims, Latin Catholics and Anglo Indians, Nadars (Hindu Nadars and Nadars included in SIUC) , SC converted to Christianity, Vishwakarmas, Dheevaras)for appointment to the post of Translator (NCA vacancy) in the High Court of Kerala. Candidates shall apply **ONLINE** through the Recruitment Portal (www.hckrecruitment.nic.in) of the High Court. No other means/ modes of applications will be accepted.

1. **Recruitment No** :09/2019 (NCA Notification for the selection year 18.01.2016 -17.01.2019)
2. **Name of the Post** : Translator
3. **Scale of pay** : ₹26500- 56700
4. **Number of vacancy** : 1 (One)
5. **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment from Other Backward Classes. (Excluding Ezhavas, Thiyyas and Billavas, Muslims, Latin Catholics and Anglo Indians, Nadars (Hindu Nadars and Nadars included in SIUC) , SC converted to Christianity, Vishwakarmas, Dheevaras)
Note:Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than that mentioned above will be summarily rejected.
6. **Age Limit** : Candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes born between 02/01/1980 and 01/01/2001(both days inclusive) are eligible to apply. A candidate who is an Ex-serviceman or Ex-general Reserve Engineer Force person or a disembodied Territorial Army person belonging to OBC category, in reckoning the age for his eligibility for appointment can exclude the period of his service in the defence forces or in the General Reserve Engineer Force or in the Territorial Army, as the case may be, and the period of unemployment on discharge up to a maximum of five years provided he has not completed the age of 50 years.
7. **Qualification** Bachelor's degree with second class (at least 50% marks) in any subject awarded or recognised by any of the Universities in Kerala.
Note:1. If the candidate possesses Bachelor Degree with less than 50% marks, he/she is not eligible to apply for the post. Rounding off to the nearest integer is not allowed. (for eg. 49.5% cannot be rounded off to 50%).
2.Wherever CGPA/OGPA or letter grade is awarded in a qualifying examination, equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the application form as per norms adopted by the University/Institute where the candidate studied. A certificate to this effect from the University/Institute is required at the time of Interview.
8. **Mode of Selection** :Selection will be on the basis of Translation test and Interview. The syllabus for the translation Test will be translation of English passages into Malayalam and vice versa; and translation of English words/legal terms into Malayalam and vice versa.
9. **Application Fee** : ₹400/-.
Note: Unemployed differently abled candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.

10. Before applying online, the candidates should read How to Apply, Guidelines for Photo & Signature, FAQ and Sample Application Form provided in the Recruitment Portal (www.hckrecruitment.nic.in) of the High Court.
11. Documents in original to prove age, qualification, Non Creamy Layer status etc. should be produced as and when called for, failing of which will entail in cancellation of candidature.
12. While applying, candidates who are in the service of the Government of India or any of the State Governments should obtain No Objection Certificate from their Head of Office or Department and keep it with them. If the candidate fails to produce the No Objection Certificate as and when called for, his/her candidature will stand cancelled. (Format of NOC is available in the link '**Downloads**' in the website)
13. While applying online for the post, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility and other norms mentioned above. The candidate should have acquired the prescribed qualification on or before the date fixed for closure of STEP-II process. The date for determining whether a candidate does possess the qualification shall be the date fixed for closure of STEP – II process.
14. Candidates should ensure that the particulars furnished by him/her are correct in all respect. Anything not specifically claimed in the application against the appropriate field will not be considered at a later stage. In case it is detected at any stage of the recruitment that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/she furnished any incorrect/false information or has suppressed any material facts, his/her candidature will stand cancelled. If any of these shortcomings are detected even after appointment, his/her service is liable to be terminated.
