The registration of the candidates will start **9.30 AM** and thereafter no application will be accepted. Candidates are to deposit their C.V. (giving details of Name, Date of birth, Father's Name, Permanent & Current Address, Educational qualification from High School/ Higher Secondary onwards with the name of Institution, Year of Passing, Marks obtained, Medium of study and field experience, with one passport size colour photograph affixed on it). They are also requested to attach self-attested photocopies of all the testimonials along with the application. The original mark-sheets, certificates, experience certificates etc are also required to be brought along with for verification on the day of interview.
- Applications for each of the position are to be submitted separately otherwise their candidature is liable to be rejected.
- Age in case of JRF should not exceed 28 years as on 01st June of the year. Further relaxation of 5 years in age to SC/ST/OBC/ Woman & physically handicapped candidates will be given as per approved rules.
