2.3 Desirable:-

- Experience in the field and performance given on AIR/ Doordarshan etc.
- Prizes won at National Level.

Note:

- The candidates having no professional qualification as per 2.2 above need not apply.**
- Before applying, for the above post candidates should satisfy themselves that they have the requisite qualifications from recognised Board/University/ Institute as on the date of closure for online submission of the application against this notification. **Those awaiting results of the final examination for the prescribed qualification are not eligible and hence should not apply.**
- Notified posts are open to all candidates and candidates belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC/ PWD /Ex. Service Man categories who apply against this notification will be extended relaxation as admissible in general open market recruitment. However, in case of being selected with any relaxation on account of being a candidate from the above categories, he/she will be taken against reserved roster point. In case the relevant Caste certificates uploaded are not found to be valid, such candidates fulfilling norms of General category will be treated as UR.
- Only the candidates qualified in the Written Test shall be called for Practical Demonstration as per merit.
- Merely registering/ filling up online application on WCR website does not entitle the candidate to be eligible for Written Examination.
- Dates for various stages of recruitment process shall be intimated through WCR website only Candidates are advised to keep their personal mobile number and personal valid e-mail active throughout the recruitment process, as all communications from RRC-WCR will be only through SMS/email. RRC-WCR will not entertain any request for change of mobile number and e-mail address at any stage.
- Candidature of the applicant is provisional at all stages of selection process subject to fulfilling the eligibility conditions.

Note:- The date of birth of candidates should be between the dates given above table (both dates inclusive).

4. Extent of Age Relaxation:-

- 4.1. Serving Railway employees who have put in a minimum 03 years of service (continuous or in broken spells) will be given relaxation of age, subject to the age limit of **40 years for Genl., 43 years for OBC and 45 years for SC/ST.**
- 4.2. The staff of Quasi-Administrative offices of the Railway Organization, such as Railway Canteens, Co-operative Societies and Institutes: The relaxation in upper age limits will be up to the length of the service rendered but subject to **maximum 05 years.** They shall submit their applications with **Service Certificate**, mentioning **the period of service rendered by them**, duly issued by their **Controlling Officer**, along with other relevant documents.
- 4.3. Widows/Divorcee Women/ Women judicially separated from husband but not remarried: **Genl.- up to 35 years, OBC up to 38 years, SC/ST- up to 40 years.**
- 4.4. Persons with Disability: **Genl.- 40 years, OBC- 43 years and SC/ST- 45 years.**
- 4.5. Persons who had ordinarily domiciled in the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01/01/1980 to 31/12/1989: **Relaxation upto 05 years.**
- 4.6. Ex-Servicemen candidate: Relaxation of age will be to the extent of service rendered by them in Defence Service plus 3 years provided they have put in a minimum of 06 months service after attestation.

5. Examination fee:-

- 5.1 The examination fee is ` 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for all candidates except those mentioned in sub-para 5.2 below with a provision for refunding ` 400/- to those who are found eligible as per the notification and actually appear in the written exam after deducting the bank charges.
- 5.2 The examination fee is ` 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty only) is required from candidates belonging to SC/ST/Ex-servicemen/Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)/Women/Minorities and Economic Backward Classes with a provision for the refunding same to those who are found eligible as per the notification and actually appear in the written exam after deducting the bank charges.

- 5.3 While applying, the candidates claiming fee exemption must submit necessary certificates i.e. SC/ST/EBC/Disability/Minorities/Ex-servicemen, in the format as prescribed (i.e. Annexure-'A', 'B', 'C', 'F') in the Central Government order.
- 5.4 If proof is not enclosed such candidates will be considered as General candidates, subject to payment of ₹ 500/- towards the fee.
- 5.5 It should be paid ONLINE using internet banking or debit/credit cards (service charges apply for all banks which will be borne by the candidates).
- 5.6 Applications not accompanied with examination fee, wherever required, will be summarily rejected.
- 5.7 Economically backward candidate means those candidates whose annual family income is less than Rs. 50000/-. They have to upload income certificate as given in Annexure-B.
- 5.8 Minorities mean Muslim / Sikh / Christian / Buddhist / Jain / Zoroastrians (Parsis).
- 5.9 Persons with disability – Only those candidates would be eligible for reservation in services/posts who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability.

6. How to apply and making ONLINE fee payment :-

- 6.3 Click on "New Registration" for Registration Number.
- 6.4 Login with Registration Number and Password.
- 6.5 Fill up details and upload the photograph, signature, self attested documents (i.e. educational qualification, certificate for proof of birth, Cultural qualification, caste certificate, etc.).
- 6.6 Click on "Examination Fee" and
- a) Accept the terms and conditions for using State Bank collect by "Click on the given Check Box (Square Box).
- b) Select the State of Corporate/Institution as "Madhya Pradesh" from the given Drop Down options.
- c) Select the Type of Corporate/Institution as "Govt Department" from the given Drop Down options and click on "Submit" Button.
- d) Select the Govt. Department as "Railway Recruitment Cell" from the given Drop Down options and click on "Submit".
- e) Select Payment Category as "Exam Fee" and enter the required information, Click on "Submit".
- f) A Confirmation page will appear, check the details and click on "Confirm".
- g) Choose the payment option from the available options and perform the transaction.
- h) After successful completion of transaction a payment receipt will be generated, take the printout of the receipt.

- 7.6 Self attested copy of certificate in proof of academic qualification as per para 2.1 of this notification.
- 7.7 Self attested copy of certificate in proof of Cultural Qualifications as per para 2.2 and 2.3 of this notification.

8. RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

- 8.1 The eligible candidates will be called for Written Test. The qualified candidates as per merit position in written examination will be called for Practical Demonstration. The candidates, who are found eligible in all respects, will be considered on the following basis.-

Written Test will consist of Objective Type Questions. There will be negative marking in the Written Test and 1/3rd of the marks allotted for the question will be deducted for every wrong answer.	50 Marks
Talent Test in the relevant field with Practical Demonstration	35 Marks
Confirmation of Talent by Testimonials / Certificates / Awards	15 Marks
Total	100 Marks

NOTE :- Written test will be conducted in both Hindi and English medium.

- 8.2 The date, time and venue of Written Examination, Practical Demonstration / Document Verification will be fixed by the RRC-WCR and will be uploaded on WCR website as well as intimated to the eligible candidates through SMS / e-mail only. Request for postponement of the Written Examination / Practical Demonstration / Document Verification will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 8.3 The question paper shall be of Objective Multiple Choice Type. The question paper will be in English and Hindi.
- 8.4 The written test shall be of 45 Minutes duration.
- 8.5 Candidates will have to write the paragraph provided, sign and affix LTI at the venue of the Written Test in the presence of the Invigilator at the Examination Hall ONLY and hand over the same to the Invigilator before the conclusion of the examination. CANDIDATES WRITING THE PARAGRAPH AND / OR SIGNING IN CAPITAL LETTERS WILL BE REJECTED.

9. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- 9.1 The candidates should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions prescribed for the cultural quota. Eligibility of the candidates for the post notified in this notification would be decided on the basis of the information furnished by them in the ONLINE application. If at any stage of recruitment or thereafter, it is found that any information furnished by the candidate in the application is false/incorrect or the candidate has suppressed any relevant information or the candidate otherwise does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for the post(s), his/her candidature will be cancelled forthwith.
- 9.2 Candidates should be in readiness to appear in the written test, practical demonstration and document verification etc. at short notice. Information regarding call letter will be sent through SMS and e-mail alerts on their registered mobile numbers and e-mail IDs, indicated in their ONLINE application.
- 9.3 Candidates belonging to the categories mentioned in Para 3, 4 & 5 seeking age relaxation/Fee exemption have to produce requisite original certificates as given in Annexures at the time practical demonstration and document verification, otherwise their candidature will be summarily rejected.
- 9.4 The candidates already employed in Central/State/PSUs including Railways should produce No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer during practical

demonstration and document verification otherwise their candidature will be summarily rejected.

- 9.5 The decision of the Railway Administration in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, penalty for false information, and mode of selection shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- 9.6 Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite Medical Fitness Test, as per the standards prescribed for the selected post.
- 9.7 Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
- 9.8 Candidates are required to obtain caste certificates in the proper Proforma from the appropriate authority and produce the original certificate at the time of verification, failing which he/she may be disqualified. This is strictly required vide Chapter 13 of the Brochure (published by Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance & Pensions Department of personnel Training, New Delhi). As large number of candidates is producing certificates issued by authority different from appropriate authority, they are advised to strictly comply with the instructions.
- 9.9 Caste Certificate issued by the Competent Authority, should not be below the rank of Tehsildar, in case of SC/ST/OBC Candidates. OBC candidates shall also submit OBC Non-Creamy-Layer Certificate in Central Government format issued within one year on the closing date of application by the Competent Authority to get the benefit of age relaxation. Certificates should contain Religion, Caste, Date of Issue etc. and bear the Seal of the Issuing Authority
- 9.10 Before applying to the post, candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the all eligibility conditions prescribed in the Notification and he/she is required to upload all necessary documents mentioned in para-7 along with his/her application. No any other document shall be entertained at the further stage of recruitment and the RRC/WCR reserves rights to reject any application, not fulfilling the eligibility condition/conditions, at any stage of recruitment.
- 9.11 Candidates must bring certificates of Date of Birth, Educational Qualification, the Certificates pertaining to Cultural and other relevant documents, all in original, on the day of practical demonstration and document verification, without which they shall not be permitted to appear in the same.
- 9.12 No TA/DA /Accommodation will be provided during practical demonstration and document verification. A candidate may have to stay for 2-3 days during selection for which he/she has to make his/her own arrangements. The Railway Administration has right to determine a valid date, postpone practical demonstration and document verification, change the place or cancel the practical demonstration and document verification due to unforeseen reasons and this cannot be challenged by any candidate.
- 9.13 The successful candidates will be posted at the discretion of the Competent Authority anywhere on the West Central Railway subject to availability of vacancies and they cannot seek transfer outside the West Central Railway for the period of 05 years.
- 9.14 Candidates qualifying in examination(s) for these posts but failing in prescribed medical examination(s) will not under any circumstance be considered for any alternative appointment.
- 9.15 Certificates in languages other than English or Hindi should be submitted by an attested translation in English/Hindi. Photocopy of all documents should be self attested.
- 10. Invalid Applications/Rejections:-** Candidates are requested to read all instructions thoroughly before submitting ONLINE application. Otherwise their applications are likely to be rejected on one or more of the following reasons. In case the application is

rejected, candidates will be able to view their status ONLINE on the website of WCR along with the reasons for rejection(s). SMS and e-mail alerts shall also be sent to the candidates on their registered mobile numbers and e-mail IDs, if indicated in their ONLINE application. Candidates will not be intimated by post regarding the reason(s) of rejection.

Applications with the following lacunae and irregularities will be summarily rejected:-

- 10.1 Applicants who are not fulfilling norms for recruitment as per para 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3 of this notification.
- 10.2 Over age or under age.
- 10.3 Certificates not uploaded/uploaded certificate are not readable as per para 7 of this notification.
- 10.4 Any other irregularities which are considered invalid by RRC.

11. Miscellaneous:-

- 11.1 RRC reserves the right to reject the candidature of any applicant at any stage of the process of recruitment, if any irregularity/deficiency is noticed in the application.
- 11.2 RRC reserves the right to conduct additional written examination/practical demonstration/document verification at any stage. RRC also reserves the right to cancel part or whole of any recruitment process at any stage for any of the categories notified in the Employment Notification without assigning any reason thereof.
- 11.3 The decision of RRC in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of application, issue of free Rail Passes, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of written examination, allotment of examination centers, selection, allotment of posts to selected candidates etc., will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained by the Railway Recruitment Cell in this regard.
- 11.4 Candidates finally selected are liable to be posted anywhere on West Central Railway and selected candidates will be taken against reserve roster point.
- 11.5 Railway Recruitment Cell will not be responsible for any inadvertent errors.
- 11.6 For any Legal Dispute, the Jurisdiction will be Central Administration Tribunal Jabalpur only.
- 11.7 In the event of any dispute about interpretation or any mistake, the English version will be treated as final.
- 11.8 Specific category and place of posting will be decided by the Appropriate Authority after finalization of panel.
- 11.9 The candidates admission at all stages of the recruitment will be purely provisional subject to fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions and instruction of notification. Dates for written Examination will be notified only on WCR website www.wcr.indianrailways.gov.in.
- 11.10 Admit card can be downloaded from WCR website www.wcr.indianrailways.gov.in.

12. Impersonation/Suppression of facts/warning:-

- 12.1 No candidate should attempt impersonation or take the help of any impersonator at any stage of the selection process. Such candidates will be debarred for life from appearing in all RRB/RRC examinations as well as debarred from any appointment in Railways; in addition, legal action may be taken against the candidate.
- 12.2 Any material suppression of facts or submitting of forged certificates/caste certificate by a candidate for securing eligibility and/or obtaining privileges. Including free travel for appearing in the examination shall lead to rejection of his/her candidature for the

particular recruitment for which he/she has applied. Further, he/she will also be debarred from all examinations conducted by all RRB/RRC over the country for a period of 02 years and legal action may be initiated, if warranted,

- 12.3 A candidate will be debarred from examinations of all RRB/RRC for a specified period/lifetime if (i) the candidate submits multiple applications for the same post and category; (ii) the candidate submits multiple applications with different community for the same post & category; (iii) the candidate submits multiple applications with different photo (face) for same post & category and (iv) the candidate submits multiple applications with different documents for the same post & category.

- 13.2 The selection of the candidate by the Railway Administration does not confer any prescriptive right on the candidate for the post.
- 13.3 The Railway Administration is not responsible for any postal delay or wrong delivery.
- 13.4 The Railway administration reserves rights to rectify inadvertent error or omission at any stage of recruitment and an erroneously appointed candidate shall liable to be summarily removed from Railway Service.

- 14 LEGAL MATTERS:** Any legal matter arising out of this Employment Notification shall fall within the legal jurisdiction of Central Administrative Tribunal, Jabalpur only.

- 15 IMPORTANT ADVISORY:** Railway Recruitment Cell, West Central Railway has not appointed any Agents or Coaching Centers for action on its behalf. Candidates are warned against any such claims being made by Persons/Agencies.
