Eligibility: Candidates who have successfully passed the qualifying Degree/ Diploma during/ after 2017 having secured minimum of 60% marks in qualifying exams and

- not taken any training as part of apprenticeship programme
- not completed post graduation in Engineering (e.g. M.E/ M.Tech/ MBA)
- not have any work experience of one year or more
- shall have standard of fitness as prescribed in the clause 4/ Schedule II of Apprenticeship Rules 1992, and amendments thereof, if any.

- 1. Candidates have to enrol themselves online in the National Web Portal <u>www.mhrdnats.gov.in</u> by providing required details and uploading the required documents to get User Id & Password.
- 2. For enrolment Candidates should have a valid email id, contact mobile number, Govt. ID (any one of Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or PAN card), Aadhaar Card, Passport Size photograph (jpeg format less than 200kB), bank account details.
- 3. After successful enrolment, the Candidates will be provided with a student enrolment number.

- 4. Web portal is being operated by MHRD, Government of India. For enquiries regarding the issues related with web portal, the candidates are requested to contact help line numbers mentioned in the web portal. Correspondence with respect to functionality of portal will not be entertained by CMTI.
- 5. Indian Nationals only need to apply.
- 6. The Institute reserves the right to adopt its own method of short-listing criteria to call for Interview and is not obliged to shortlist all the candidates who fulfil the minimum requirement.
