It is as follows:

1. There will be a Screening Test (Objective Type) comprising two papers i.e. General Studies & General Abilities and General English. These tests are meant for short listing the number of candidates to be admitted to the Main (Conventional Type) Examination.
2. Main Examination consisting of three compulsory papers. The number of candidates to be admitted to the Written Examination (Conventional Type) based on performance in the preliminary examination is in the ration of 1:15 in respective categories duly following the rule of reservation.
3. All the papers except English Language to be answered in English or Telugu or Urdu as chosen by the candidate. However, a candidate will not be permitted to write Main examination papers in other than the language already chosen by the candidate.
4. Candidates must appear for all the papers in Main examination and Oral test, who qualified for the same. Absence in any of the above will be liable for disqualification for final selection.
5. Minimum qualifying marks in General Studies & General Abilities paper are 40% for O.Cs., 35% for B.Cs and 30% for SC/ST/PH.
6. The General English paper in Screening test is for qualifying one and the standard of this paper is that of **S.S.C.** The minimum qualifying marks in this paper are 40% for O.Cs., 35% for B.Cs and 30% for SC/ST/PH. **Screening test marks are not counted for Ranking.**
7. The minimum qualifying marks in General English paper are not relaxable.
8. The selection of Candidates for appointment to the post will be made in two successive stages viz., (1) Main examination and (2) Oral Test in the shape of interview.
