Emoluments: As per current University norms, Guest Faculty will be paid a consolidated monthly salary of Rs. 30,000/- for one course/4 hours per week. Those required to teach two courses will be paid Rs.45,000/-. Also, as per F&A rules, 10% or 20%, respectively for those with and without PAN, may be deducted towards income tax, unless a certificate of exemption from a competent authority is submitted.

Qualifications:

Essential:

- (i) M.A. in English or Communications with a minimum of 55% marks (with language components) and NET/JRF.
- (ii) M.A. in any area of English language studies or other allied disciplines with a minimum of 55% marks and NET/JRF.
- (iii) Ph.D. in English Language Studies/English Linguistics.

Desirable: PGDTE and/or M.Phil. in English Language Studies/English Linguistics.
