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Eligibility:

i) For the Disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Humanities, Education, Social Sciences, Sciences, Languages, Library Science and Journalism & Mass Communication.

A.

- i) A master's degree with 55 % marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/ relevant/allied subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum standards and Procedure for Award of Mphil /Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D programme prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances /Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assitant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored /funded /supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B.

The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign University /institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds(QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai jiaoTong University(Shanghai).

ii) Drama Discipline:

Eligibility (A or B)

A.

- i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian /foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a PhD degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M. Phil/Ph.D degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the PhD programme, prior to July 11, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The PhD degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode;
- b) The PhD thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open PhD viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two reserach papers from his/her PhD work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her PhD work in conferences/seminars supported/funded/ sponsered by the UGC/CSIR/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note:

1. *The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.*

2. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B.

A traditional or professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who has:

- i) been a professional artist with three years' Bachelor degree/Post Graduate Diploma, with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed), from the National School of Drama, or any other such institution in India or abroad;
- ii) Five years of regular acclaimed performance at regional/ national/ international stage, supported by evidence; and
- iii) the ability to explain, with logical reasoning, the subject concerned *and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.*

NOTE:

- 1) A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
- 2) A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- 3) A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 4) A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
- 5) The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/ promotion.

● **Age limit as on 01.01.2020 (for Assistant Professor) : Below 40 years**

Note:

Upper age limit prescribed will be relaxed in the case of OBC, SC/ST and Physically challenged persons by three years, five years and ten years respectively subject to relevant provision of KS&SSR.

Application Fee: Rs. 2000/- (Rupees TwoThousand Only)

Note: SC/ST candidates need to remit only Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only)

Mode of Remittance:

Application fee is to be remitted through Calicut University Instant Payment System only. The system can be accessed either through the link Instant Web Payment System in the university website(www.uoc.ac.in) or directly through <https://www.uoc.ac.in> and clicking on the "instant Pay" Tab. The purpose of remittance " APC101 -Application fee for various Posts/Courses" may be selected from the list. If an applicant desires to apply for more than one post separate remittance of fee has to be made.

How to apply:

- 1) Prescribed application form for Online submission and other details are available in the website of University of Calicut (www.uoc.ac.in)
- 2) Candidates need to furnish one set self attested copies of all certificates/documents in support of their claim (this includes copies of certificates proving age, caste/community, educational qualification, experience teaching/research projects, research publications and all other achievements including credentials in proof of the API scores claimed) along with the print out of the application.
- 3) Short listed candidates have to submit 6 copies of self attested copies of all certificates /documents in support of their claim and original certificates for verification at the time of interview/screening.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1) Separate application and fee are required for each post if the candidate is applying for more than one post.
- 2) **Last date for online submission of application: 05.02.2020.**
- 3) Completed application enclosing one set of self attested copies of certificates to prove educational qualifications, age, community, experience, equivalency(and showing percentage of marks issued by the concerned University (in cases where percentage of marks not specified in the marklist) etc. should reach the undersigned on or before **20.02.2020**. The date of determining the eligibility in every respect shall be the normal closing date prescribed for the receipt of Online application.
- 4) OBC candidates claiming reservation have to produce the certificate issued by competent authority that they do not belong to the Creamy Layer as per the Government Order in force.

- 5) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Universities outside Kerala should upload the equivalency certificate obtained from this University at the **time of application**.
- 6) Reservation benefits shall be applicable to only those communities which are mentioned in the KS&SSR. Natives of outside Kerala State will not be considered for the posts which come under community reservation quota.
- 7) The University reserves the Right for cancellation of proceedings, in full or in part, as per this notification without assigning any reason thereof.
- 8) Only short listed candidates will be called for the interview.
- 9) The details of short-listed candidates will be published in the website of University of Calicut.
- 10) The applicant will be solely responsible for the authenticity of the information submitted.
- 11) Any addendum/corrigendum to this notification will be published only in the website of the University of Calicut and no newspaper notification will be issued.
- 12) NOC from the Employer, if applicable is to be submitted at the time of application
- 13) No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates attending the interview.
- 14) Other stipulations prescribed by the UGC /University/Government of Kerala shall be mandatory for all posts.
- 15) Applications which are not complete and are not in accordance with the above directions are liable to be rejected.
