- **2. Age, educational qualification and work experience** as on **01.12.2019** for the above posts are prescribed as under :

The Bank functions in a computerised environment and all of its branches are on a core banking platform. Hence, working knowledge of computers (including spreadsheets, word processing, email, etc.) is essential and should preferably be supported by a Certificate / Diploma in this regard.

a) In the case of candidates belonging to SC / ST/OBC / PH, minimum qualifying marks will be 45% in aggregate, other conditions remaining the same. b) The educational qualifications prescribed for the above posts is the minimum. 3. Important information about educational qualification:

5. Selection process: The selection of candidates will be made on the basis of performance in the written test and interview. The written test will consist of objective / multiple choice type questions on English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, Test of Reasoning, Current Affairs and General Knowledge (which will also include questions on computer operations (spreadsheets, word processing, email, etc.). Final selection shall be made on the basis of ranking of the aggregate marks obtained in the Written Test and Personal Interview. Decision of the Bank in this regard shall be final.

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The selected candidates will be on probation for a period which shall not be less than twelve (12) months (which may be extended at the discretion of the Bank). During the probation period, they will be entitled to Initial Basic Pay of Rs.25,000/- for the post plus admissible Dearness Allowance only. They will be required to undergo a course of training during the probationary period. Subject to satisfactory completion of the probationary period and on completion of the training course successfully, they will be absorbed in the Bankâ \in TMs services in the Bankâ \in TMs scale as applicable for Bank Assistant-cum-Cashier â \in TM II and thereafter they will be entitled to draw other allowances and facilities admissible to the post under the Staff Rules.
