**Selection for the post of HC (GD) in CRPF through  
Limited Departmental Competitive Examination-2019.**

1. Applications are invited from serving male / female Constables (General Duty/Bugler /Mali/Painter) of the Force for the Group-C post of Head Constable (General Duty) in the Central Reserve Police Force through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE)-2019 as per MHA Scheme issued vide U.O. No. R.II-15/2011(HC-LDCE)/Pers-II dated 14/07/2011 and Standing order No. 05/2011 & its addendum/amendment issued vide letter No. R.II.15/2012-Rectt.(HC/LDCE) dated 03/07/2012. The posts are temporary but likely to become permanent in accordance with the guidelines of the Government.

**4. Eligibility conditions:**

Constables (General duty / Bugler / Mali / Painter) only in the Force having following qualifications / qualitative requirements (QRs) will be eligible to appear in the examination.

<p><b>Stage- V: <u>Medical Examination.</u></b></p> <p>Detailed Medical examination of those candidates who come out successful in the written, PST, PET &amp; Scrutiny of testimonials/records will be conducted as per existing guidelines in the Force and instructions issued from time to time. Each candidate will be declared either fit or unfit and no one will be categorized “<b>Temporarily unfit</b>”.</p> <p>Pregnancy at the time of PET will be disqualification and pregnant female candidate can be rejected at that time only. However, if any such women candidates who as a result of tests and the time of medical examination is found to be pregnant of 12 weeks standing or over shall be declared temporary unfit and her appointment will be held in abeyance until the confinement is over.</p>		
<p><b><u>STAGE- VI Drawal of Merit list</u></b></p> <p>After completion of Medical examination, merit list in each category namely General(UR) and SC / ST will be drawn separately as per existing instructions on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in the written test, weightage for above 4 years of service in the rank of Ct, Good grading in Courses and Sports achievements. 10	<p><b><u>HOW TO APPLY</u></b> All willing and eligible candidates will apply offline through their Units/Offices only in the application form (Proforma enclosed). Application must be accompanied by NOC as per enclosed proforma of <b>Appendix-‘A’</b>.</p>
11	<p><b><u>GENERAL</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Written examination will be conducted on 19/04/2020.</li> <li>2. The responsibility for conducting examination is entrusted to Central Sector and GC Allahabad is detailed as Nodal centre/GC for scrutiny of applications etc.</li> <li>3. Procedure and other conditions as envisaged in S.O-05/2011 and its addendum/amendment instructions issued vide this Directorate letter No. R.II.15/2012-Rectt.(HC-LDCE) dated 03/07/12 may be adhered strictly for conducting the test and category wise final as well as combined merit list be submitted to this Dte as per programme.</li> <li>4. Head of Office will ensure dissemination of information about selection of HC/GD through LDCE to all eligible candidates in their unit / office.</li> <li>5. Candidates must apply for NOC on plain paper to their Head of office. Candidates will submit their applications in time. No late application will be accepted. Candidates be advised accordingly.</li> <li>7. It is the responsibility of Head of Office to ensure issuance of NOC to only willing &amp; eligible candidates for selection to HC/GD well in time and service book of the applicant is the only authentic document to confirm his eligibility conditions. If any candidates submits certificate with regard to Course undergone by him and entry not available in Service Book, the same may be accepted after verifying with original or from concerned unit/office.</li> <li>8. Eligibility parameters at initial screening stage rests with unit/office itself and fulfillment of eligibility criteria should be ensured by Head of Offices before issuing NOC to the candidates for applying for the post of HC/GD through LDCE-2019.</li> <li>9. Central Sector is designated as Nodal Sector for subject selection and GC Allahabad as the Nodal GC.</li> <li>10. Application form, Service book &amp; ACR/APAR with all other connected documents (viz, NOC, AME Report, Certificate to prove educational qualification etc.) of the eligible candidates will be forwarded by H.O.O to the <del>in</del> <b>Zonal Headquarter</b> well in time through Spl. messenger.</li> <li>11. In cases where service records of personnel are not available, the unit/office will intimate their details to the respective GC/Office immediately for forwarding their service record to their respective Zonal Hqr timely through special messenger.</li> <li>12. 	<p>book to their respective Zonal Hqr well in time alongwith application form, NOC, AME report, certificate to prove educational qualification etc.</p> <p>13. Eligible personnel who are on leave or other duties be informed immediately, assisted through quickest communication means and fax. A record of such communication with aspiring candidates will be kept by the respective unit/office.</p> <p>14. Each Zone will detail a Board of Officers for screening of service records/checking of eligibility conditions etc. at Zonal HQrs and submit final proceedings to nodal GC/Sector for needful.</p> <p>15. A candidate applying for LDCE and his application is accepted then his chance shall be taken into account. In case, a candidate is not able to physically appear in selection process due to unavoidable circumstances, he has to produce evidence in support of his not appearing in LDCE for protection of his admissible chance. The HOO will forward the case with specific recommendations to Sector IG who will take decision on merit of each case and issue necessary order accordingly. In case a candidate is not able to appear in the selection process due to his own negligence then his chance will not be protected.</p> <p>16. A special cell may be set-up at Nodal Sector Hqr. at the time of selection process of HC/GD through LDCE for better communication with identified centres and RecttDte to address queries, if any, raised by the lower formations. Further for better, speedy and timely redressal, mobile numbers of special cell members be provided to all identified centres. Nodal Sector and GC will put in place a system when the B.O.O so detailed for scrutiny is in constant touch H.O.O for any want of documents not made available by H.O.O. This is applicable during scrutiny period the B.O.O so detailed be spared from all other duties, assigned a separate room with connectivity and perform scrutiny religiously to ensure that no eligible candidate is left out and no ineligible candidate is admitted.</p> <p>17. In case of eligible personnel on deputation, it will be the responsibility of the Parent Office i.e. the office/Unit from where the individual proceeded on deputation to inform the concerned individual regarding conduct of subject examination through the borrowing department or any other means. Such personnel may apply immediately for NOC and forward his application <u>within the time schedule given for submission of application alongwith NOC.</u></p> <p>17. GC Allahabad (Nodal GC) will also detail a board/cell of composition as prescribed for centre level to clarify the relevant queries raised by Recruitment Boards. Further, mobile number of all special cell members be provided to all indentifiedcentres for better co-ordination. Mobile no. of supervisor/DA of Dte. may also be kept with members of Spl. cell for immediate clarification on doubts/queries which could not be sorted out at sector/centre level.</p> <p>19. These instructions/guidelines are not exhaustive, therefore, Zone/Sectors may issue necessary instructions / directions to DIG's of examination centres and PO Rectt.board, if any, required keeping in view the ground realities at their end.</p>
12	<p>Following guidelines are also issued in this regard:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. ACR grading in respect of recruits who have passed 44 weeks of basic training be treated as 'Good'.</li> <li>2. SCC is now re-named as HCPC, hence additional marks as weightage for good grading of HCPC may be awarded to eligible candidates. Candidates who have undergone BPT,</li> </ol>

- APT, UAC and TOT courses from other than CRPF Institution i.e. BSF, ITBP, CISF, etc. may be allowed. Grading of BPT and APT courses with "A" and "B" grade may be treated as "AX" and "BX" accordingly. If a candidate has undergone two or more courses and obtained good grading, only one course i.e. the course in which the candidate had obtained highest grading (best grading) will be taken into account for awarding weightage of marks for Good grading. Marks will not be awarded for the remaining courses. ToT course of minimum 5 weeks duration only be considered.
3. Notification of examination may be announced in marker / Roll Call / meetings / Sainik Sammelan etc and all the aspirants of above examination be made aware/reiterated about the schedule and eligibility requirement which they have to fulfill for appearing in examination.
  4. If a candidate does not meet physical standard, he/she may be rejected at initial stage of scrutiny by unit or concerned centre.
  5. No candidate who availed condonation in physical standard during his/her appointment in lower rank earlier and on the date of submitting application for LDCE is not meeting required standard, his application is liable to be rejected at initial stage/unit level and he will not be eligible to appear in the examination.
  6. In case, candidate availed condonation in physical standard at the time of recruitment in lower rank and later on gained the required physical standard during the period of time due to growth, his/her eligibility may be checked from AME report, which is the authentic document to confirm their correct physical standard (height/chest & weight etc.) / eligibility conditions in support of their claim.
  7. Details of candidates applying for the post of HC/GD through LDCE-2019 should be ascertained by Unit/Offices immediately on issue of notification and following course of action taken by Units/offices issuing NOC :-
    - i) Since Service records of personnel posted in Units are held with Group Centres, a suitable representative (Ministerial staff) should be detailed to proceed to Group Centre alongwith list of candidates of the Unit applied/appearing for HC/GD LDCE-2019 and check the entire details in the Service record properly to ascertain the eligibility criteria for issue of NOC.
    - ii) H.O.O issuing NOC will take immediate action for updating ACR file in respect of aspiring/applying candidates by quickest means.
    - iii) AME is valid for one year period. It must be ensured that the candidate is in SHAPE-I category at the time he/she applies for LDCE. However all such candidates, where their period of AME validity expires within the opening and closing date of applications, they may be advised in their own interests to get their fresh AME conducted immediately, irrespective of validity of date and then apply for the post.
  8. The Service Book and ACR with all other connected documents of the eligible candidates will be provided by the HOO to their respective Zones well in advance without fail. Units will take special efforts and use of all communication measures and ensure that Service record, ACR and related documents reaches their respective Zone well in advance.
  9. All documents related to requisite educational qualification required for appearing in the selection should be available in the Service Book of the personnel.
  10. The scrutiny board will ensure that the candidates meet all eligibility parameters. The Board will be responsible to ensure that the candidate is eligible as per NOC provided

- by Head of Office and further from Service Records/ACR etc and rule out any possibility on eligibility which might have been overlooked by H.O.O./Commandant.
11. There will be no provisional acceptance of application in this examination. Responsibility of non acceptance of application due to non completion of any Adm requirement will lie on H.O.O. Individual is also responsible for completion of his AME/records etc. for submitting his application duly completed in all respect in time.
  12. The candidates not fulfilling the eligibility conditions on the date of application will not be eligible for applying for LDCE.
  13. **Guidelines for written examination:**
    - i) All identified examination centres will issue necessary directions to earmarked units/offices/institutions whose candidates are appearing at that particular centre for dispatching aspirants well in time to appear in written examination on schedule date.
    - ii) The Sector HQrs, under whose jurisdiction the recruitment centres fall, should issue instructions/directions to recruitment centres for smooth conduct of written examination.
    - iii) Question booklet and OMR sheets will be supplied by Nodal Sector i.e. Central Sector on the basis of demand.
    - iv) I/Card will be treated as proof to prove identity of the candidate. Before allowing candidates to enter in examination hall, identification of candidates should be verified/call letter should be checked and they should be allowed to position their seat in examination hall **30 minutes in advance** from starting of **written exam**.
    - v) Sealed packets will be opened on fixed date/time in the presence of candidates in examination centers.
    - vi) **15 Minutes time** will be given to candidates for filling up column of OMR answer sheet, Question Booklet, going through the instructions on OMR Sheets and briefing etc. The Q/A booklet provided in stapled form will not be opened during the 15 minutes duration.
    - vii) The invigilator detailed for conducting written examination should brief candidates to fill up correct/complete information in respective columns of OMR answer sheet before start of exam to avoid rejection during scanning process. Besides, invigilators should also ensure that above requirement is correctly filled up by each candidate while collecting OMR sheet from candidates.
    - viii) Candidates should mark correct answer by darkening only one of the choices in the OMR answer sheet. If more than one oval are darkened, the answer will not be evaluated.
    - ix) The OMR Answer sheets not bearing candidates name, Roll Number, language option code, Category, Question booklet series number, series code, signature, etc at appropriate columns/boxes earmarked for this purpose, fully and correctly, will not be evaluated and zero marks will be awarded to them. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by Department.
    - x) Candidate should not write irrelevant matter on answer sheets and should not be in possession of mobile phones, calculators and other electronic gadget/computing devices or any other devices etc. in the examination hall, failing which his/her candidature shall be cancelled.



xi) Candidates indulging in copying/helping others/using unfair means should be disqualified from examination and remarks to this effect be recorded. In addition disciplinary action as deemed appropriate shall be taken against them.

xii) Candidates are directed to bring blue and black ball pen and clip board for answering question on OMR sheet.

**14. Evaluation of answer sheets:**

i) As evaluation of OMR answer sheets is computerized and double scanned, no requests for re-evaluation shall be entertained.

ii) On completion of written examination, OMR answer sheets and question booklets should be handed over to the invigilator by the candidates before leaving the examination hall. Carbon copy of the OMR answer sheet will be provided to the candidate.

iii) Double scanning/evaluation of OMR sheet will be conducted. On completion of written examination, OMR answer sheet of all centres will be sent through a Board member for scanning at the designated place. On completion of double scanning /evaluation of OMR sheets the firm will hand over centre wise list of candidates qualified in the written examination (**in order of roll number**) without mentioning marks scored to the Nodal Sector/GC.

iv) Answer key of all sets of question paper will be checked by a B.O.O at Nodal GC after written examination and before uploading result to avoid any complication at later stage. Candidates will be given chance to represent against any question(s) within the time limit.

v) On receipt of confirmation about correctness of answer key from Nodal GC, the key of the written examination question paper will be uploaded on CRPF website [www.crpf.gov.in](http://www.crpf.gov.in).

15. PST / PET will be conducted of shortlisted candidates after written examination.

**16. Medical Guidelines:**

i) Candidates declared unfit in medical examination be informed immediately duly mentioning deformity/disease after conducting medical examination. They may also be advised to prefer appeal if any against error of judgment alongwith necessary documents & remedial examination fee in accordance with SR-4 within 15 days of rejection by medical board.


ii) While conducting medical/review medical examination, all existing/latest instructions (including color blindness) issued by Directorate as well as Director Medical should be adhered strictly by medical board. Besides, provisions contained in SR-4 for conducting review medical examination should also be complied with strictly while processing appeal for review medical examination.

iii) As per S0-5/2011 candidates who are declared unfit in medical examination will prefer appeal to concerned sector IG conducting HC/GD LDCE. Therefore all candidates declared unfit in medical examination be directed to prefer appeal if any, for review medical examination to IG concerned along with requisite documents in accordance with provision envisaged in rule-4 of SR, FR & SR Part-I (General Rule).

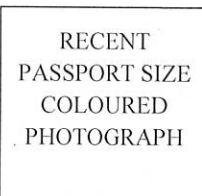
iv) On receipt of result of qualified candidates from all examination centers, Nodal Sector/GC concerned will consolidate and prepare category wise as well as combined merit list as per existing instructions for male and female candidates. After drawal of merit list of finally selected candidates, same will be submitted to Zone concerned for further submission to Dte after ensuring correctness of procedure and instructions on the subject by zone.

17. **Selection of candidates:**

- i) With regard to check clean records of service/blemish in service and counting of ACRs, fresh guidelines issued vide Rectt. Dte letter No. R.II.15/2014-17-Rectt-I (SI/LDCE) dated 26/04/2018 may be adhered strictly.
