**Selection for the post of HC (GD) in CRPF through
Limited Departmental Competitive Examination-2019.**

1. Applications are invited from serving male / female Constables (General Duty/Bugler /Mali/Painter) of the Force for the Group-C post of Head Constable (General Duty) in the Central Reserve Police Force through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE)-2019 as per MHA Scheme issued vide U.O. No. R.II-15/2011(HC-LDCE)/Pers-II dated 14/07/2011 and Standing order No. 05/2011 & its addendum/amendment issued vide letter No. R.II.15/2012-Rectt.(HC/LDCE) dated 03/07/2012. The posts are temporary but likely to become permanent in accordance with the guidelines of the Government.

3. Pay: 7th CPC Pay Matrix Level-4, Rs. 25,500 - 81,100/- plus allowances like DA, HRA, CCA, and other allowances as admissible under Rules.

4. Eligibility conditions:

Constables (General duty / Bugler / Mali / Painter) only in the Force having following qualifications / qualitative requirements (QRs) will be eligible to appear in the examination.		
a)	Service eligibility	They should have completed four years of service including basic Training on the last date of application. However, Constable having more than 04 years of service shall be considered for weight-age of marks as under :- Upto 4 years - No marks 4 - 5 years - 04 Marks 5 - 6 Years - 08 Marks 6 -7 Years - 12 Marks 7 - 8 Years - 16 Marks Above 8 Years - 20 Marks Marks awarded on the basis of No. of years of service completed as Constable will be taken into account for aggregate marks only while drawing merit list for selection.
b)	Upper age	The upper age limit for appearing in the LDCE will be <u>32 years</u> . The Cut off date for determining age of candidates for accepting applications will be 1st August 2019.
c)	Educational Qualification	10 + 2 pass from a Board or university recognized by the Central or State Govt.
d)	Clean record	(i) They should have minimum Good ACRs of last four years and should

APARs of last 04 years should be considered which may be 4, 3 APARs or more in number.</p> <p>(ii) Candidates awarded minor or major punishments/penalties under relevant sections eg. j)	Application to be submitted in prescribed form along with four numbers of passport size photographs.																
k)	Proforma for Admit Card for written examination and PST, PET and DME are attached. After filling all particulars in relevant columns of the proforma, same may be submitted alongwith application.																
l)	In case the information furnished by the applicant is found false at a later stage, his/her selection will automatically stand cancelled & he/she will be reverted back to original rank.

	Selection process consists of following stages:																
	Stage-I (Written Examination)																
	At the very beginning written examination will be conducted. The written test will consist of only OMR based objective type multiple choice questions. The bilingual question paper should be of 160 marks comprising of 160 questions consisting of one mark for each question with 3 hours duration. The question paper will be of 10+2 pass standard.																
	i) General intelligence, awareness, reasoning ability	Numerical 60 Marks															
	ii) Professional Knowledge	70 Marks															
	iii) Language comprehension and Communication skill	30 Marks

<p>Note : The cut off percentage of marks for appointment will be 50% in aggregate. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to candidate belonging to SC / ST categories only. However it will be necessary to secure 45% qualifying marks in each part of the examination for General/ OBC and 40% for SC/ST candidates.</p>

Stage- V: <u>Medical Examination.</u>		
<p>Detailed Medical examination of those candidates who come out successful in the written, PST, PET & Scrutiny of testimonials/records will be conducted as per existing guidelines in the Force and instructions issued from time to time. Each candidate will be declared either fit or unfit and no one will be categorized “Temporarily unfit”.</p> <p>Pregnancy at the time of PET will be disqualification and pregnant female candidate can be rejected at that time only. However, if any such women candidates who as a result of tests and the time of medical examination is found to be pregnant of 12 weeks standing or over shall be declared temporary unfit and her appointment will be held in abeyance until the confinement is over.</p>		
<u>STAGE- VI Drawal of Merit list</u>		
<p>After completion of Medical examination, merit list in each category namely General(UR) and SC / ST will be drawn separately as per existing instructions on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in the written test, weightage for above 4 years of service in the rank of Ct, Good grading in Courses and Sports achievements. Aggregate marks for drawal of merit will be 220 Marks (160+20 +20+20). No waiting list of successful candidates will be kept and the shortfall vacancies will be filled through promotion. List of finally selected candidates will be uploaded on CRPF website.</p>		
7.	<u>TRAINING :</u> The selected candidates will have to undergo separate LDCE course and will be put on probation for 2 years.	
8.	<u>RELAXATION</u> The relaxation for SC / ST candidates will be admissible as per instructions issued by the government from time to time.	
9	<u>TIE PRINCIPLE</u> In case of tie in marks, the merit list will be prepared in the following order :- (a) Older Age - The candidates with older age shall be placed higher in merit. (b) Alphabetical Order - The candidate whose name comes first in alphabetical order (English) shall be kept higher in the merit list.
