- In case the application for the posts under reserve category will not be received, the same posts will be filled up from Un-reserved category candidates. However, the General Candidate can apply against the said posts.
- In case the application for the post of Associate Professor for the Department of Neurology, Endocrinology & Medical Gastroenterology on contract will not be received, the same post of Associate Professor will be filled up from the down grade post of Assistant Professor for the Department of Neurology, Endocrinology & Medical Gastroenterology. However, the candidates can also apply for the post of Assistant Professor against the said post
- The last date of receipt of ONLINE application is 18.03.2020 upto 05:00 Pm and the last date of receipt of Hardcopy of applications alongwith requisite documents upto 23.03.2020 either by post OR by hand in the Room No 228, Diary & Dispatch Section , Level-II, Block-D, Hospital Building, Sector-32/B, Chandigarh-160030. The applications received after due date will not be considered under any circumstances and will be rejected straightaway and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

- The list of eligible candidates/not eligible candidates and date of interview will be displayed on GMCH website later on and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- Candidates are advised to visit the website on regular basis for updates. No separate/individual intimation through post etc. will be sent.

Note 1: All Medical/Non-Medical Teachers must possess a basic University or equivalent qualifications included in the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. They should also be registered under the State/ Central Medical Registration Act.

2. HOW TO APPLY ON LINE

- (i) The candidate should apply only Online for the above said posts till **18.03.2020 upto 04:00 P.M.**
- (ii) The application is to be filled up Online on website www.gmch.gov.in by clicking on 'VACANCIES'.
- (iii) Before filling up On-line application, the candidate must have his/her signatures & photograph scanned in the JPG format, which should not exceed in size i.e. (<20KB) and it has to be uploaded at the time of filling up of Online Application Form.
- (iv) On successful submission of form on the website www.gmch.gov.in, candidates are advised to retain one copy of the print-out of the form, which will have Registration Number/Application ID printed on it, for further enquiry.
- (v) The candidates are directed to fill up all the columns carefully as the information once filled by the candidate will be treated as final and cannot be altered at any later stage. The information filled by the candidates while applying online will be treated as final.
- (vi) Online registration shall commence on **03.03.2020** and shall close on **18.03.2020** at 04:00 P.M.

NOTE:-

1. The candidates should fill his/her Application form available on the GMCH website w.e.f. **03.03.2020** He/she should fill up all the relevant fields in the form. No field/Column should be left blank.
2. Category of reservation should be entered in the prescribed column of the online application form. No addition or change of category of reservation will be allowed once form has been submitted.
3. The candidature of the OBC candidate will be only be considered whose caste will falls in the central list of Other backward class meant for UT, Chandigarh available at website www.ncbc.nic.in

III. APPLICATION FEE DETAILS:-

3. TENURE OF THE POST

The above said posts are purely temporary in nature and will be filled up on Contract basis, as a stopgap arrangement or till his/her services are required by the Chandigarh Administration. It is also made clear that it is an engagement for a fixed term and shall automatically cease on the expiry of the term without providing any claim to a person so engaged to any regularization of service or any consequential benefits.

4. UPPER AGE LIMIT AS ON 01.01.2020:

The upper age limit for the above said posts on contract basis are not exceeding 50 years.

5. EMOLUMENTS (On Contract Basis):

The emoluments to be paid on Contract Basis for the following posts are as under:-

- i) Associate Professor: Initial pay Rs. 48,590/- + NPA (wherever applicable) + Dearness Allowance (as revised for time to time).
- ii) Assistant Professor: Initial pay Rs. 46,000/- + NPA (wherever applicable) + Dearness Allowance (as revised for time to time).

6. RESERVATION AND RELAXATION:

- (a) The reservation and relaxation in the upper age limit will be made only for the category of the post reserved for such categories, as per the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- (b) The SC candidates applying for un-reserved posts are not entitled to any relaxation in upper age limit.
- (c) The category like SC will be considered only when the same is accompanied by the certificate issued by the competent authority and category once claimed in the application form will not be changed later on under any circumstances.

7. Application Fee:

- i) The candidates should fill his/her Application Form available on the GMCH website. He/she should fill up all the fields in the form. No field/column should be left blank. The ONLINE fee payment mode will be available in application form.

- ii) Candidates must note that no other mode of payment of application fees like Demand Draft, Banker Cheque, Money Order, etc. will be accepted under any circumstances. The GMCH will not be responsible for any remittance made in any



form other than the method prescribed above and such applications without requisite application fee submitted through any other mode except prescribed in column ii above are likely to be rejected.

- iii) The candidates should ensure that they submit the online application alongwith payment of fee immediately, since the same is non-refundable. No representation/request/demand for refund of application fees will be entertained, if the candidate fails to apply on-line within the stipulated time after payment of application fee.

8. OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- i) It is made clear to all the candidates that their candidature is provisional and further subject to the fulfillment eligibility criteria, age, verification of documentary proof. In case, they do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, overage, their candidature will be rejected straightway and they do not fulfill the eligibility will not be called for interview under any circumstances.
- ii) The above said posts are purely on contract basis as a stop gap arrangement initially for a period of six months/one year or till the regular incumbent are join on the post through UPSC, New Delhi whichever is earlier.
- iii) **In case the application for the posts under reserve category will not be received, the same posts will be filled up from Un-reserved category candidates. However, the General Candidate can apply against the said posts.**
- iv) **In case the application for the post of Associate Professor for the Department of Neurology, Endocrinology & Medical Gastroenterology on contract will not be received, the same post of Associate Professor will be filled up from the down grade of Assistant Professor for the Department of Neurology, Endocrinology & Medical Gastroenterology. However, the candidates can also apply for the post of Assistant Professor against the said post.**
- v) The candidates who are willing to apply for the above said posts must have the essential qualification, experience etc. stated above, as the case may be as on **18.03.2020** i.e. last date of receipt of Online applications.
- vi) The numbers of posts and reservation thereof are tentative and can be increased or decreased. The department reserves the right to reject/cancel any application or withdraw the posts at any time without assigning any reasons or without any notice whatsoever and in this regard, no application fee will be refunded.
- vii) List of provisionally eligible candidates and date of interview for the said posts will be displayed on the GMCH website later on.
- viii) No separate letter for Interview will be sent.
- ix) The candidates will be called for interview based on their eligibility. However, the decision of the competent authority as to their eligibility or otherwise of a candidature for interview or selection will be the final and no correspondence/personal enquiries will be entertained.
- x) Candidates are required to have a valid personal e-mail ID which should be kept active during the recruitment process, as all the information relating to recruitment of the said posts will be available only on On-Line. - xiv) No Travelling Allowance/Daily Allowance/Conveyance Allowance will be paid to the candidates, who are called for the interview.
