5. RESERVATION AND RELATED INFORMATION:

a.	The rule of reservation is applicable as per the rules in force. Detailed instructions with regard to reservation can be seen in Annexure-2 and 3 of this Notification.
b.	The number of vacancies advertised is only an indicative number and is liable for change with reference to vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection for appointment.
c.	Defence personnel released or likely to be released from the Armed Forces due to disability incurred in forward areas while on duty, will also be selected if they are found to be otherwise qualified and if the Medical authorities are satisfied that the disability is not such as would render them incapable of efficiently discharging the duties of an Assistant Surgeon (General).
d.	If no qualified and suitable women candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
e.	Separate reservation of 3.5% within the 30% reservation available for Backward Classes is applicable to Backward Class Muslims (BCMs). All the concessions / relaxations / benefits applicable to BC candidates are applicable to BC Muslim candidates as well.
f.	The expression B.C (i.e. Backward Class) wherever it occurs including online application form, should be read as "B.C. (other than BCM) and B.C. (Muslims)", [BCMs denotes Backward Class Muslims].
g.	Reservation for differently abled:- Provisions of Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Amendment Act 2017 (Act 30 of 2017) will be applicable. 4% of the posts are reserved for Differently Abled candidates as per G.O.(Ms.) No. 21, Welfare of Differently Abled Persons (DAP-3.2) Department dated: 30.05.2017. The details of disabilities suitable as per G.O.(Ms) No.20, Welfare of Differently Abled Persons (DAP.3.2) Department, dated: 20.06.2018, are furnished hereunder and such candidates have to produce a certificate of

	physical fitness from the Medical Board. That Certificate should be obtained from the Medical Board of a Government Medical college.

6A. AGE (as on 01.07.2020) :

Note:

- Sub-Section 8 of Section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act- 2016 shall be applicable to this recruitment.
- Applicants not belonging to SCs, SC(A)s, STs, MBC&DCs, BCs, BCMs who have put in 5 years or more of service in the State/Central Government are not eligible to apply even if they are within the age limit.

Age concession for Ex-servicemen:-

“Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or in the special rules for the various State and Subordinate Services, an ex-serviceman who has not completed forty

eight years of age, if he does not belong to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe or Backward Class and fifty three years, if he belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled

Tribe or Backward Class on 1st July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made, but is otherwise qualified and whose name is suggested by a local Employment Exchange for appointment to a vacancy under the Government notified to it shall be eligible for such appointment.

“Persons serving in the Armed Forces shall be eligible to apply for posts under the Government if they are due to Complete the specified term of their engagement in the Armed forces within one year from the last date prescribed by the appropriate authority for receipt of the application in respect of a particular recruitment. All such candidates while making their applications shall submit a self undertaking and a form of certificate from their Commanding Officer in the format given in Annexure – 8 of this Notification. ”

[Section 63 of Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016.]

Note 1:

“Ex-serviceman” means,

- I. any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union and has been released therefrom on or before the 30th June 1968 otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency; or
- II. any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union for a continuous period of not less than six months after attestation and released therefrom between 1st July 1968 and 30th June 1979 (both days inclusive) otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency; or
- III. any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union for a continuous period of not less than six months after attestation if released between 1st July 1979 and 30th June 1987 (both days inclusive)
 - i. for reasons other than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency; or
 - ii. at his own request after serving for a period of not less than five years; or

IV.any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union, and had retired or had been released on or after

1stJuly 1987 from such service:

- i) at his own request after earning his pension;or
- ii) on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond
- iii) his control and awarded medical or other disability pension;or
- iv) otherwise than at his own request after earning his pension, as a result of reduction in establishment; or
- v) After completing specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given agratuity.

V. any person of the Territorial Army of the following categories, namely, pension holder for continuous embodied service, person with disability attributable to military service and gallantry award winner retired on or after 15thNovember1986; or

VI.any person of the Army Postal Service, who retired on or after 19th July 1989 directly from the said service without reversion to Postal & Telegraph Department with pension or who has been released on or after 19th July 1989 from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension;or

VII. any person discharged on or after July 1987 under Army Rule 13(3) III (V) for the reason that his service is no longer required and in receipt of pension;

Note 2: Ex-service Men – does not mean the wards of those mentioned above.

Note 3: In all cases, an Ex-Serviceman once recruited to a post in any class or service or category, cannot claim the concession of being called an Ex-serviceman for his future recruitment.

Note 4: a person discharged before July 1987 under Army Rule 13 (3) III (V) for the reason that his Service is no longer required is not an Ex-serviceman. An applicant who claims to have been demobilised from the Army or Navy or Air Force should produce in support of his claim properly authenticated extract from his Discharge Certificate in the following form:-

- (3) Date of enrolment
- (4) Date of discharge
